Hispano Round Table Scholarship Requirements:

- **First year entering College or first year entering graduate school.** Must be planning to enroll in at least two courses during the next term at a 2 or 4 year institution and plan to use the funds for education expenses. Class schedule or matriculation letter necessary, when available.
- Scholarships are awarded based on character, personal merit and commitment. Merit is demonstrated through leadership in school, civic and extracurricular activities, academic achievement, and motivation to serve and succeed. Must have demonstrated academic success (with a minimum grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale) Commitment to community. Applicant will be judged on values parallel to the Hispano Round Table, a civil rights organization.
- **Must report back to HRT on yearly basis, we invite you to be active in the HRT. Appearance preferred, will accept letter correspondence. We ask that you come before the HRT within the first 6 months after receiving the award. Award dependent on relationship and visit.**

Checklist

- Application Deadline January 31, 2008. Please be available to attend. All Applications due to Post Office Box 27298 postmarked by January 31, 2008. Electronic portions can be E-mailed to info@hrtnm.org (electronic applications preferred)
- Copy of the financial aid report and proof of family income (previous year IRS form or personal statement). Financial need must be established.
- High School Transcripts, College Transcripts
- We recommend you submit 2 letters of recommendation. Feel free to add any additional documentation you feel pertinent. The review committee will best get to understand your accomplishments with the more documentation you provide.
- Personal Statement from Applicant. Consider how you can most effectively convey your best qualities. How are you the best qualified for the HRT Scholarship? A theme for the HRT is advocacy, how can advocacy make a difference? How are you an advocate for the community?
